Mission to Masaai Mara

Circle of Love Foundation joined World Outreach Ministries Foundation May 1-10, 2010 in an outreach to Lolgorien, Kenya, a remote community in Masaai Mara. We held a free 5 day clinic in which 1145 patients received free medical consultations and medicine, dental extractions, reading glasses and voluntary HIV testing and counseling. The Gospel was shared each afternoon in the market area and a Bible based film was shown each evening. 120 people, including many children, indicated a desire to follow Jesus. The church is composed of about half Massai, one of the prominent tribes of Kenya. The rest are mostly Swahili speaking people from other tribes. There are many children in the church. The grounds where the church meets were taken over by the community council about 2 years ago during the unrest that followed the last presidential election. They have acquired new land. They are required to move the church building and the school from the land but for
