- Turn left (southeast) on CR 219
- Travel 1/2 mile on CR 219 to the Camp Tejas entrance on the left

FROM LA GRANGE

- Hwy 71 (bypass) and Hwy 77 intersect north of La Grange
- Travel 16 miles north on Hwy 77 to the Camp Tejas sign at County Road 220
- Turn left (southwest) on CR 220
- Travel 2 miles on CR 220 to CR 219
- CR 220 ends at CR 219
- Turn left (southeast) on CR 219
- Travel 1/2 mile on CR 219 to the Camp Tejas entrance on the left
