New LCCS Athletic/Fine Arts Complex Opens

Students from kindergarten through 12th grade at Lake Country Christian School are now using the school's new Athletic/Fine Arts Complex. Located at the corner of Bailey-Boswell and Boat Club Road in northwest Fort Worth, the state-of-the-art 67,000 square-foot facility is home to a practice gym seating 225 and a competition gym that seats 1700. The facility accommodates all P.E. classes, athletic practices and competitions as well as weight-room training.

The unique third floor area of 16,000 square feet houses the Fine Arts Suite with specialized rooms for band, choir, art, a black box teaching theatre, and a dance studio/rehearsal hall. In addition, a computer lab for music theory, technical theatre and graphic arts and four practice rooms expand the offerings in fine arts.

The complex has helped relieve scheduling and space issues for the school. "We are so blessed by the many opportunities our beautiful new building affords our faculty, students and their families," commented LCCS Head Administrator Nancy Purtell. The complex is large enough to host future regional and/or state competitions and tournaments with eight locker rooms, two concession areas, and office space.

The LCCS sports and fine arts programs have had a successful school year. Varsity teams in every sport have qualified for post-season play with the Eagles winning the TAPPS 3A State Basketball Championship. The fine arts department presented the musical, *Cinderella*, with a cast of 65 in five performances at the Scott Theatre in Fort Worth's cultural district, while the HS Jazz Band received a perfect score at TAPPS State Competition. The department gives 300-400 private lessons a month in all areas from band to voice, guitar, piano, and dance.
