

**ROCK SOLID HIGH SCHOOL
APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Application Deadline: JULY 1, 2010

1. Complete the entire **APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION** form. If you do not have enough room to complete the answer to a question, finish your answer on a separate piece of paper.
2. Please be sure to carefully read the entire STUDENT HANDBOOK. You will be asked to verify that you, the parents, and your student have read the entire handbook. We are not trying to inconvenience you, but have limited room for enrollment. It is critical for all concerned to understand what the mission and values of Rock Solid High School are, going into the program. Academic excellence is just one goal of our school. Equally important is the attitude and behavior of students toward teachers, fellow students, and the overall student atmosphere of the RSHS community.
3. The **HOME SCHOOL INSTRUCTOR** form should be filled out by the primary instructor.
4. The **TEACHER/COUNSELOR RECOMMENDATION** form should be filled out by someone who knows your student well, such as a coach, music instructor, or Scout or Awanas leader.
5. The **PASTOR'S RECOMMENDATION** form should be filled out by your Pastor.
6. Please include a copy of the results of your student's most recent **STANDARDIZED TEST** (within the last two years). Examples include: Woodcock-Johnson, Iowa Test of Basic Skills, California Test of Basic Skills (CTBS), California Achievement Test, Stanford Achievement Test, CSAP, etc.
7. Sign the **PARENT EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT** and **STUDENT EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT** forms after reading the RSHS handbook.
8. Fill out and sign the **LIABILITY RELEASE** form.
9. Fill out completed and physician-signed **IMMUNIZATION** card.
10. **FEES:** Our current tuition is \$330.00 per month for 10 months beginning August 1, 2010 and totaling \$3,300 for the year. **Please include a non-refundable, \$100.00 registration fee** with your application. (This fee does not apply to your tuition.) Make checks payable to: Rock Solid High School. Part-time classes are \$800.00 per 1st class, per year. For more information regarding more than one course, please contact the school office. The fees are subject to change.
11. In addition to the written application, there will be a **PERSONAL INTERVIEW** with the prospective student, their parents, and representatives from RSHS. The interview will be scheduled after your entire application packet has been received. The interview process is designed to answer questions for all concerned: students, families, and RSHS. This interview is intended to ensure that students and parents share the vision and values of RSHS. We want to prevent conflict during the year due to misunderstandings on how students should interact with each other, how students should treat instructors, and how parents should support teachers, students, and RSHS. We feel that the initial time invested to discuss and agree on the mission and vision will prevent the potential for misunderstandings during the academic year.

13. If there are any concerns or issues not satisfactorily addressed by the applicant either on these forms, or during the interview process, which do not conform to the mission and vision of RSHS, the board of RSHS reserves the right to deny admission to the applicant.
14. We will interview families as completed applications are received and will start a waiting list when the appropriate class size is reached.

16. There is a required **MATH PLACEMENT TEST** to enter RSHS. Please call the school office at 303-797-1005 to sign up for the math test. There is a \$5.00 fee for the test. The tentative dates for the tests are Wednesday, May 12, 2010, and Saturday, July 17, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. at Rock Solid High School.
