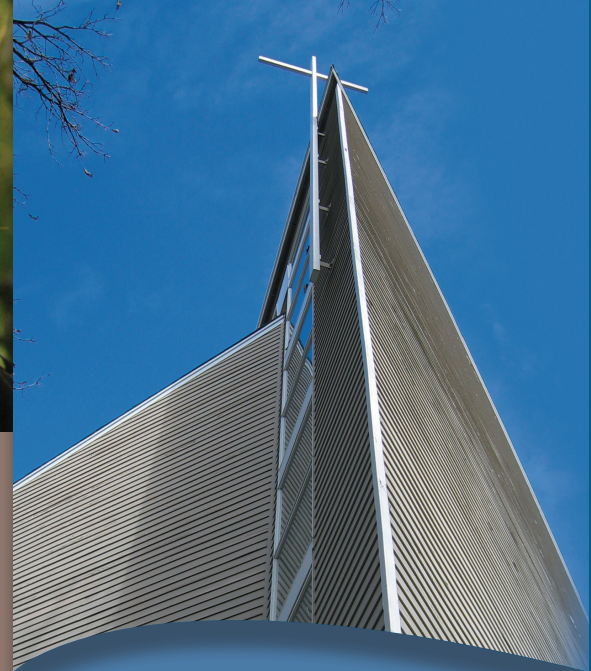
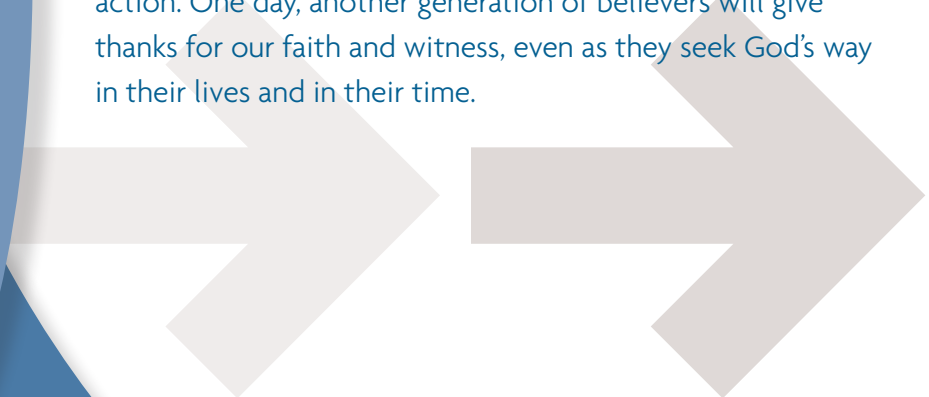


OUR STORY
