Introduction

Primary Tasks and Responsibilities of the Committee

The primary tasks and responsibilities of the student ministry advisory board include but are not limited to:

- assessment of the effectiveness of all student ministry events

Organization and relationships

Student ministry advisory board membership will include the director of student ministries and a representative from the staff-parish relations committee. One member will serve as a representative to the church council. Membership will include a Sunday school teacher, a mid-week Bible study volunteer, a middle school parent, and a high school parent. Members will be recommended by the committee on lay leadership to the annual charge conference. Additional members may be added by the director of student ministry as needed. Members will serve a maximum of two years.

The student ministry advisory board works cooperatively with other programming and administrative councils and committees and is responsible to the church council.
