After winning the female division, Traylor stated that "although not her personal best, she was still happy" with the outcome. 14-year old Jonathan Baerwald of Plant City delivered a performance deserving of a standing ovation with a 4th place finish of 20.25.

After all the excitement of the race, the runners were rehydrated with Gatorade and farm fresh Strawberries from Plant City's own Astin Farms. While the Strawberry Distance Challenge itself was full of memorable moments, it also brought together our community in an effort to raise resources for two very important ministries.
