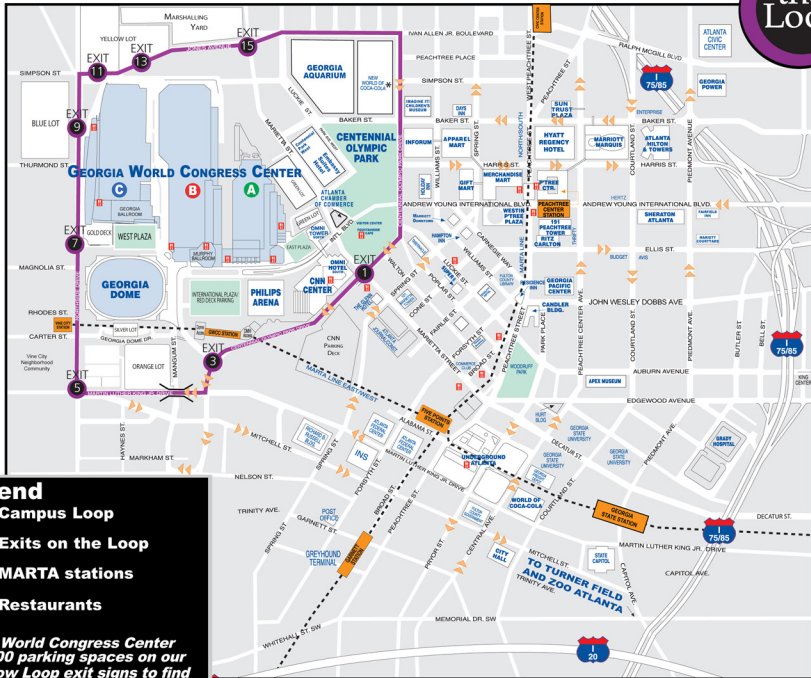




# Georgia World Congress Center Authority Loop Map
