APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLICATION:

Students desiring to attend the Antioch School for the purpose of completing a Masters of Ministry degree program in theological education as an alternative to traditional seminary training must:

1. Demonstrate:

- Ability to complete academic work at the advanced post-secondary level (masters-level). This is usually done with official transcripts showing that a bachelors degree has already been earned from a college or university, transcript showing admission and/or academic work already done at the master-level, or graduate school placement test results.
- Expressed interest in advanced development of competencies associated with being a minister of the gospel (pastor, church planter, vocational missionary) or other ministry leaders.
- Three years of ministry leadership experience (or its equivalent).
- Capacity to learn through extensive implementation in real ministry situations.

2. Make application to the Antioch School Partner Program at Lutheran Church of the Cross using the Lutheran Church of the Cross Pastoral and Ministry Leadership Training Support Application Process Procedures found on the LCC website under Antioch School Partner.

3. Receive affirmation and approval by the Board of Spiritual Oversight to possess required demonstrations (above) to make application to the Antioch School of Church Planting and Leadership Development.

4. Complete the Application for Admission to Degree or Certificate Program for the Antioch School of Church Planting and Leadership Development. Forms are found at the back of the HANDBOOK and online at <http://www.bild.org/antiochSchool/download/general/admissionApplication.pdf>.

5. Meet with the Advisory Committee of the Antioch School Partner Program at Lutheran Church of the Cross. Local faculty (to oversee the academic plan of study and portfolio process) and a mentor (to oversee the spiritual and personal development plan and assessments process) will be assigned.

6. Sign up for classes being offered.
