All people submit to Christ (Ephesians 5: 21)

Wives Submit to your husband (Ephesians 5: 22-24)

Husband love your wife like Christ loved the Church

(Ephesians 5: 25-33)

Children obey your parents (Ephesians 6:1-4, Deut 5:16)

foundations (Titus 1:11, 1 Tim 3)

This is how we become established and more like Christ

(Colossians 1:28, Ephesians 4:17-32)
